### **NEW BRUNSWICK KENNEL CLUB – Reserve Winner's Dog – Judge Jon Cole – March 23, 2012**

This dog came out of the puppy class. Needs maturity, but a nice young one. Balanced with good bone and feet. Had a good downface, and well-placed eyes. He was a bit unruly going around the ring.

### **GOLDEN TRIANGLE BULL TERRIER CLUB –Reserve Winner's Dog – Judge Phil Brodeur-June 23, 2012**

Litter brother to Winners, his cross is a very bad mouth. Pity, because absent that he could have given his bro a run for the roses! A bit more bully than his brother, he has a very good head with power, width and fill. Nice front and shoulder and good bone. Two fine lads!

### **THE BTC OF NIAGARA FRONTIER – Reserve Winner's Dog - Judge Bob Thomas – August 31, 2012**

All white, decent profile, slight mouth fault, nice bone, good expression.

### **THE BTC OF NIAGARA FRONTIER – Winner's Dog - Judge Norma Smith – September 1, 2012**

Young heavyweight puppy with really good bone. Powerful head with good fill, great strength and depth. Tiny well placed eye offering keen expression. Good solid front construction with clean foreleg and nice tight feet. Bite just off. Moved well in front, adequately behind.

### **THE BTC OF NIAGARA FRONTIER – Winner's Dog - Judge Gordon Smith – September 2, 2012**

Heavyweight youngster with a powerful well filled strong head through to the muzzle. Would like to see more length of head. Bite off. Good legs and feet with excellent round bone. Moved very well in front, a little less so behind.

### **DEVON – Winner's Dog, Best of Winner's, Best of Variety - Judge Linda Flegg - October 6, 2012**

Wow what a picture of a dog. In profile I love the balance and angulation and love the virtues of this dog. Head is strong and muzzle is deep with good under jaw (even if he is undershot) Good expression, eye set and ear placement. The angulation of this dog is just superb front and rear, nothing overdone or underdone. The width of fore chest, lovely straight front, tight cat feet are pleasing to the eye. Neck flows into a short back. Strong second thigh, good turn of stifle and well let down hocks. If I could be picky I would like a little more spring of rib and a tad shorter loin but it is still in balance with the overall dog.

### **MONTGOMERY COUNTY KENNEL CLUB --Reserve Winners Dog – Judge Heidi Holland – October 7, 2012:**

Powerful dog with tons of bone and substance, and then some! He has a strong head which is packed up under the eyes possessing great width and strength of muzzle. A little short in foreface with resultant mouth fault. He has the tiniest, blackest, deep set eyes which I would like to see set a little higher. Could do with better angulation through forequarter. Correct topline and tailset finished off with a strong rear end that is well angulated with well defined hocks – he moves particularly well behind.

### **BTCA NATIONAL SPECIALTY –Reserve Winner's Dog – Judge Stephen Craven – October 14, 2012**

Power-packed dog, with perfect egg-shaped head and totally wicked eye, unfortunately his mouth is not his virtue. He has great depth of forechest and correct shoulders, he moved with good drive and was true both ways. I liked him a lot. I was happy to award him Reserve Winners Dog today.

**New Brunswick Kennel Club - Best of Opposite Sex - Judge Rudi Dettmar – March 23, 2013**

Almost 2-year-old, mid-sized white male that exudes power and strength, excellent head, excellent earset and wicked expression, deep chest with width, short in back, good-sized bone, lovely cat feet and an excellent mover.

**Bronx Kennel Club – Winners Dog, Best of Winners and Best of Variety - Judge Bill Poole – March 24, 2013**

Big, upstanding white dog with a filled and turned head. Mouth incorrect. Very good bone. Tight feet. Good bodylines. Moved well both coming and going.

**Philadelphia BTC – Winner's Dog, Best of Winners – Judge Claudia Sharp – April 26, 2013**

Baxter's **OC Corsaire Devilish Delight @ Dogmore O'Malvern** (GCH Corsaire The Courier & CH OC Harbour Light's O'Malvern)

Powerful white. Head is strong all the way through the muzzle. Tiny dark eye, placed correctly on the head. Mouth is off. Well balanced with straight front, large bone and tight cat feet, good rear angulation. Moved with power and drive.

**Philadelphia BTC – Reserve Winner's Dog – Judge Ray Sharp – April 27, 2013**

Baxter's **OC Corsaire Devilish Delight @ Dogmore O'Malvern** (GCH Corsaire The Courier & CH OC Harbour Light's O'Malvern)

Head is strong and muzzle is deep with good under jaw. Good expression, eye set and ear placement. The width of fore chest, lovely straight front, tight cat feet are pleasing to the eye. Good turn of stifle. Ideally could be a tad shorter in back. Significant mouth fault.

**Philadelphia BTC – Winner's Dog, Best of Winners - Best of Opposite Sex – Judge Naomi Waynee – April 28, 2013**

Good rear angulation. It was a close decision for Winners Dog. He also pushed hard for the BOV placement. I understand he finished his championship on the day. Congratulations to his breeders and owner!

**New England BTC – Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed – Judge Mark Phillips – May 31, 2013**

Best of Opposite Sex(White) and to BOB: Baxter & Allen's Ch OC Corsaire Devilish Delight@ Dogmore O'Malvern.

Really powerful , heavyweight white dog. Super powerpacked head with sweeping profile. Mouth incorrect. Piercing expression. Straight front with neat feet. Well sprung ribs. Muscular quarters which he really drove from and covered the ground. Very close decision for BOB, but he seemed to be more affected by the heat than the bitch.

### **New England BTC – Best of Variety, Best of Breed – Judge Scott Ibbitson – May 31, 2013**

Best of Variety and Best of Breed

Baxter and Allen's CH OC CORSAIRE DEVILISH DELIGHT @ DOGMORE O'MALVERN (GCH Corsaire The Courier ex CH OC Harbour Lights O'Malvern) Let's get the negative out of the way first: his mouth is 'way off'. Enough said! All bull terrier in this package. A powerful- looking dog who catches your eye immediately when he enters the ring. Big broad topkull with ears small and erect and right on top. Clean gently-turned head that is completely packed with bone all the way down to his nose. Small triangular eyes that are well-placed and deeply- set into the skull. Front-on his expression is piercing. A beautiful straight gun barrel front with elbows well tucked and tight cat feet. Thick round heavy bone throughout. Wonderful spring of rib and body volume. To be a wee bit picky and enhance the "wow factor", he could have just a bit more length of neck and shortness of back. Well-angulated hindquarter that is well-muscled and with a pronounced second thigh. On the move, he covers the ground squarely and effortlessly coming towards, going away and when viewed from the side. This masculine dog may not be everyone's cup of tea due to his mouth fault, but he is full of virtue and has what this breed lacks. He easily won Best of Breed with room to spare.

### **Ladies Dog Club – Best of Opposite Sex – Judge Caroline Alexander – June 1, 2013**

This powerful, young male is striking and extremely handsome both in head quality, expression, and body make and shape. Tiny dark eyes, good depth in muzzle, undershot, instanding canines. Excellent bone and substance. Very well made with solid topline, good depth of chest. Balanced. Moved well and purposefully.

### **Framingham Dog Club– Best of Opposite Sex – Judge David Alexander – June 2, 2013**

A large, very masculine dog of great density throughout, he also possesses massive bone. He has keen expression composed of neat, erect ears, a small well set eye and good muzzle width. In profile his head is gently curved but appears to have a bit of flatness due to having a bit too much brow. Good depth of muzzle. This dog has many qualities but unfortunately his canines are quite instanding, which is a significant current concern. He moves really well, maintaining a correct topline, showing good angulation both front and rear.

### **Golden Triangle BTC – Best of Opposite Sex – Judge Bill Lambert – June 21, 2013**

Heavyweight masculine powerful dog. Beautiful head, filled up and with a classic arc. Deep under jaw, very heavy round bone. Good firm topline and excellent rear angulation with well let down hocks and good second thigh. Has just the right combination of power and substance yet still has excellent shape throughout. He mouth is undershot nevertheless he has more than enough virtue to carry this and he also moves well driving out will long powerful strides.

**Golden Triangle BTC – Best of Opposite Sex and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed – Judge Carolyn Lambert – June 21, 2013**

Substantial dog with super, heavy bone, short back and well angulated quarters. Deep and wide barrel chest. Straight front and right up on his toes. Strong head, filled right up with a lovely expression. Undershot mouth. Moved out with power and drive.

Very masculine, square dog. Heavy bone. Compelling dog front on. Packed up head. Delightfully wicked eye makes for an excellent expression. Mouth fault. Deep chested. Strong round bone extending right down through tight cat feet. Deep bodied with good spring of rib and depth to the chest. Well set on hind quarters. Moves most truly coming, closely going and fluidly to the side.

**Canadian Shield Trophy Show – Reserve White Dog – Judge Russell Lamonby – July 20, 2013

All round virtuous dog, strong packed head, a little short in foreface and his mouth is off. Nice round bone, good front, adequate feet. After careful consideration and discussion we decided to award him **Reserve White Dog** on account of his many virtues, but it was a close call between him and #5.

**Bull Terrier Club of Philadelphia Wilmington Kennel Club- Best of Opposite Sex - Judge Phil Brodeur - April 25, 2014**

Excellent bone and substance. Head is strong, with good width and very good fill, pleasing gentle profile. Mouth under. Nice small eye, well-shaped and placed. Moves jauntily, consistent with his typey, short-backed body. Good neck and shoulder, angulation moderate on both ends. This dog offers many virtues not often found in one package.

(in a good way) Front on, he has squinty little eyes in a large, packed-up head that is egg shaped. His bite is off. Front exhibits legs that are straight with oodles of bone. Good feet. Side view shows thick, strong neck, short back and proper topline with tail set on perfectly. Excellent depth of brisket, but a bit more forechest would be nice, although from the front he has a nice barrel chest. Rear is strong and powerful. Moved out with a jaunty air that is a classic Bull Terrier trait. A bit of a swagger, the way it should be.

Head is heavy and masculine, and although not as turned as some, it is very much to standard with its gentle arc and is well filled with bone. Expression is varminty. Underjaw is deep and strong, mouth is quite incorrect. Neck is somewhat thick and well-muscled, topline short and strong with tremendous ribspring and body volume. Chest is very broad viewed from the front. He is short-coupled and square in outline with great body type. Typey, well-balanced and short-coupled, the essence of masculinity in a Bull Terrier.
